ABOUT THE PLAY

Jason, a young lawyer fights to build a legal case against a human trafficking ring in Thailand. His investigation centres on Number 18, a young prostitute working in a Bangkok brothel whose testimony could make or break the case. Thrust into circumstances beyond his control, Jason is haunted by Voices that usher 18 to her fate. Can he win the trust of 18 and convince her to risk her life to testify for the sake of justice?

Inspired by an event in April of 2008 in which an abandoned storage container was found in Thailand containing 121 workers from Burma, 54 of them dead, Andrew Kooman's *She Has a Name* dramatically gives human trafficking a face.

There are **27 million slaves** in the world. Experts estimate nearly **1 million** people are trafficked every year into some facet of the sex trade. Human trafficking is the **fastest growing** criminal trade, second only to the illegal sale of drugs, with an estimated annual profit of over **31 billion US dollars**.

These statistics are staggering. Yet it is important to remember that **each person** caught in slavery **has a story**, a story that will likely go unheard.
